Linked through a customer's secure corporate network, the One Link Table System provides a powerful, secure and easy-to-use means of configuring and monitoring select table games.

Paltronics also offers a suite of table bonusing games that add excitement to the casino floor, plus a range of industry leading LCD screens that bring games and promotions to life.

The One Link® Table System also gives dealers the ability to control the display channels and volumes, using a keypad as well as, the ability to have the display indicate when a player requests a service, such as ordering a drink.

The One Link® Table Displays are able to be integrated through the One Link 3E Media network, to display streaming media such as a movie or graphic feeds in portions of the display to promote other activities within the casino.

Customized graphics and scripting are available separately as is the network infrastructure to link gaming data from the One Link® 3E Media System (if applicable).

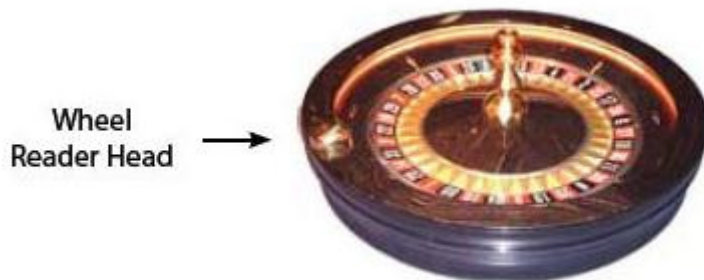


What is the Roulette System?

The Roulette System provides a graphics LCD display for the Roulette table game and can be used with any standard roulette wheel. It has the capability to display game information and statistics, promotional messages and media.

The Roulette System consists of the following components:

- Table Display Controller (with or without tuner card).
- LCD display (17" or 24", single or double sided).
- Wheel Reader Head (available in selected jurisdictions).
- 10-button Dealer Keypad (20-button allows for winning number entries on jurisdictions where no wheel reader can be installed).



How do the Roulette Game and Display Interact?

Game play starts when the roulette wheel is spun. When the ball is put in play by the dealer, an animation plays that wishes the players "good luck".

After the ball has slowed down to a certain speed, an animation plays that indicates "no more bets" allowed.

Once the ball lands on a winning number, it is read by a reader head on the roulette wheel. The winning number is displayed in the game history column of the graphic display, and then a series of game statistics are displayed.

The game statistics show which play areas on the table are winners, as well as displaying odds and hot numbers.

What is the Sic Bo System?

The Sic Bo System provides a graphics LCD display for the Sic Bo dice table game. It has the capability to display game information and statistics, promotional messages and media.

The Sic Bo System consists of the following components:

- Table Display Controller (with or without tuner card).
- LCD display (17" or 24", single or double sided).
- 10-button Dealer Keypad.

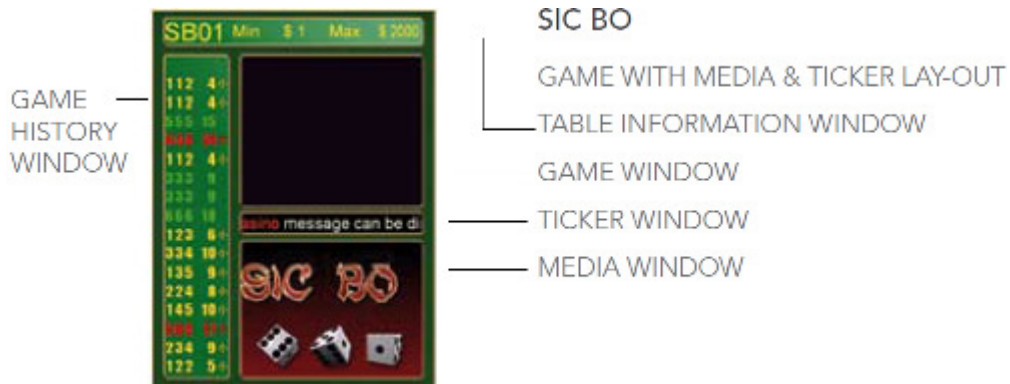
How Does the Sic Bo Game and Display Interact?

Sic Bo is a dice game with three dice. Once the dice are rolled, the dealer records the result of the dice. The game results are shown on the display.

Game Play Information	Explanation
New row	New roll of dice
Red row	Big roll (dice total = 11 to 17)
Yellow row	Small roll (dice total = 4 to 10)
Green row	Triple (same number on all dice)

The above table indicates the meaning of the dice results and scoring information that is displayed in the game play information window.

Display Graphics:



Additional layouts are available to choose from and each provides a different placement of winning numbers, promotional messages, table game information and streaming media.

What is Pontoon Pandemonium?

Pontoon Pandemonium is a variation of Blackjack, with some great new ways to win.

Pontoon Pandemonium is an optional side or ante bet that can be placed in addition to your regular wager.

When you place a Pontoon Pandemonium side or ante bet you have the chance to win an additional bonus prize of up to \$25,000.

Aim of the Game:

Pontoon Pandemonium is played like Blackjack. You play against the dealer.

The major difference is that Pontoon is played with decks of 48 cards with the four tens removed. (Ten of Hearts, Diamonds, Clubs and Spades)

As with Blackjack, the dealer initially deals two cards to each player and one card to him/herself. You then have the opportunity to draw extra cards and improve your total.

To win, generally your total must be greater than the Dealer's total without exceeding 21.

Like Blackjack, Pontoon is when the first two cards dealt to you are an Ace and a picture card (King, Queen or Jack).

However, with Pontoon Pandemonium, there are numerous other ways of winning.

Pontoon Pandemonium Jackpots:

On Pontoon Pandemonium, you have the option of placing an additional Pontoon Pandemonium bet. Simply place \$1 in addition to your original wager in the area required for Pontoon Pandemonium bets.

When you place a Pontoon Pandemonium side or ante bet, you are betting that the next hand dealt to you will be Pontoon.

If the next hand dealt to you is pontoon, you will be paid at odds of 3 to 2 as normal and have the opportunity to win an extra cash prize by pressing the Jackpot Button.

Each player winning a Pontoon Pandemonium bet will have the opportunity to press the Jackpot Button.

After the Jackpot Button is pressed the prize won is displayed on the Pontoon Pandemonium Bonus Meter.

If you are not dealt a Pontoon, only your \$1 Pontoon Pandemonium bet will lose and is collected by the Dealer, and play continues.

Table Min/Max Displays:

As casino operators look for more ways to upgrade the look of their property while enhancing efficiency, Paltronics delivers a new line of LCD Min/Max Table Displays that bring a sleek high-tech feel to the pit while leveraging the centralized management and time-saving features of its renowned One Link® System.
